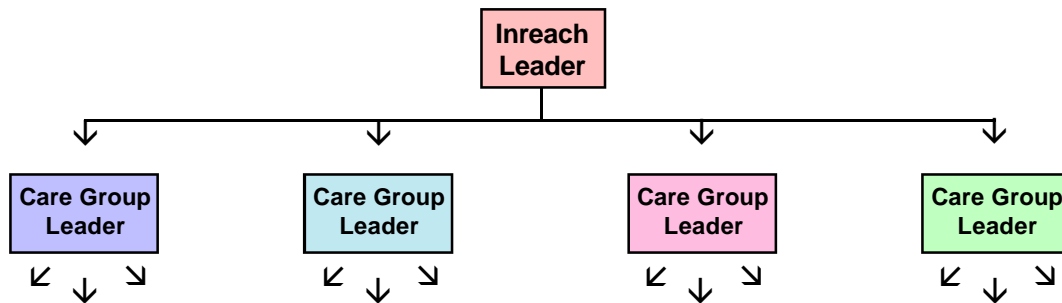


MAKE PROVISION FOR INTENTIONAL INREACH

We need to help every member to make friends and to have the opportunity to give and receive care. We can do this by sub-dividing each Bible Study group into smaller care groups units, each led by a Care Group Leader. Each Bible Study group should assign someone to serve as the Inreach Leader. The Inreach Leader's responsibility is to oversee and coordinate the work of the Care Group Leaders.



The class Inreach Leader will ...



- divide the class into care groups of 6 to 8 people.
 - assign a care group leader to each care group.
 - work with the care group leaders.
 - keep in weekly contact with care group leaders.
 - reach out to guests and new members to the class and make them feel welcome.
- report any member needs to the teacher, division director, or a church staff member.
 - attend any training meetings and other church-wide events that will aid him/her in their spiritual growth and equip them to better perform their assigned task.
 - assist in obtaining care group member information and assigning new members to groups.
 - cooperate with fellow class leaders in planning, doing, and evaluating inreach and outreach activities.
 - always be positive and enthusiastic, never sharing any negative remarks about the class, teacher, members, or church.
