2	Frogs	Exodus 8:1-15	<i>"Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Go to Pharaoh..." (8:1)</i>
3	Gnats	Exodus 8:16-19	<i>This plague comes without warning.</i>
4	Flies	Exodus 8:20-32	<i>"Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Get up early in the morning and confront Pharaoh..." (8:20)</i>
5	Plague on livestock	Exodus 9:1-7	<i>"Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Go to Pharaoh..." (9:1)</i>
6	Boils	Exodus 9:8-12	<i>This plague comes without warning.</i>
7	Hail	Exodus 9:13-35	<i>"Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Get up early in the morning..." (9:13)</i>
8	Locusts	Exodus 10:1-20	<i>"Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Go to Pharaoh..." (10:1)</i>
9	Darkness	Exodus 10:21-29	<i>This plague comes without warning.</i>
10	Death of firstborn	Exodus 11:1 — 12:36	<i>"Now the Lord said to Moses, 'I will bring one more plague..." (11:1)</i>
